THE HALL OF FAITH

Hebrews 11:32-40

Introduction:

- A. The sports world has their Hall of Fames, and yet God already did that for the Bible World.
- B. A fast paced journey of those who paved the way of faith and lived a life of faith as an example for us today.

I. HONORABLE MENTION—VS. 32-38

- A. Gideon—a judge and military leader, had assembled 32,000 men and God cut his forces down to 300 to show that He was the one giving the victory—Judges 7:12; 16-21
- B. Barak—was a faithful servant of the Lord who aided the judge Deborah and their fight against Jabin the Canaanite king and their commander Sisera—Judges 4:8-9; 21-22
- C. Sampson—isn't known for his faith, but for his strength. We are inclined to judge Sampson for his weakness, yet God commended his faith.
- D. Jephthah—known for his foolish vow, yet his trust was in the Lord—Judges 11:29-32
- E. Samuel—was not a warrior, but fought idolatry and immorality.—I Samuel 3:19-21
- F. The prophets—their description is Hebrews 11:33-38
 - 1. “stopped the mouths of lions”—Daniel
 - 2. “quenched the violence of fire”—Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego.
 - 3. “women received their dead raised to life again”—Elijah
 - 4. Sometimes terrible things are inescapable for God's people, how you face them, demonstrates your faith.
