Luke 17:11-19

I. THE MAGNITUDE OF GOD'S GIFT (v. 12, Col. 1:21, Phil. 2:5-11)

Note: Notice these lepers were standing "afar off" the Bible refers to the lost man as being "alienated" or completely separated from God. We must never forget the magnitude of God's Gift. Phil. 2:5-8.

- A. We Find that Jesus Left Some Things
 - 1. the splendor of Heaven
 - 2. the constant presence of the Father
- B. We Find that Jesus Took Upon Himself Some Things
 - 1. the form of man/flesh
 - 2. the form of a servant
 - 3. the sting of death
- C. We Find the Reason for These Things
 - 1. his father's love
 - 2. his father's love for you
