MOSES—THE RELUCTANT FAITHFUL SERVANT

Hebrews 11:23-26

Introduction: Exodus 3-4

- A. Moses doubted His name—vs. 13
- B. Moses doubted His effectiveness:
 - 1. Rod into a serpent—4:2-4
 - 2. Hand into leperousy—4:5-7
 - 3. Water into blood—4:8-9
- C. I can't talk—4:10-17
- D. Yet despite his doubts and his hang-ups, Moses spoke with God face to face and was a friend of God—Ex. 33:11 and Deut. 34:10

I. MOSES HID—VS. 23

- A. The faith of the parents (Amram & Jochebed)
 - 1. To defy the law
 - 2. Feared God more than they feared Pharaoh
 - 3. It took great faith to place their son in that ark.
- B. God rewarded their faith—they were given permission to raise their son.

II. MOSES REFUSED—VS. 24

- A. He was raised as a prince, yet he knew who he really was.
- B. Acts 7:20-23

III. MOSES CHOSE—VS. 25

- A. A choice to deny *fleshy* desires for *spiritual* desires.
- B. To identify himself as one of the slaves.
- C. We are a slave to sin, yet many will not admit what we really are. We enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season, and we will make a choice.

IV. MOSES ESTEEMED—VS. 26

- A. He valued:
 - 1. Treasure in Heaven more than treasure in Egypt.
 - 2. Peace with God, more than peace with Pharaoh.
- B. He gave thought to the consequences of his actions—his testimony—his future—God's desire for his life!
