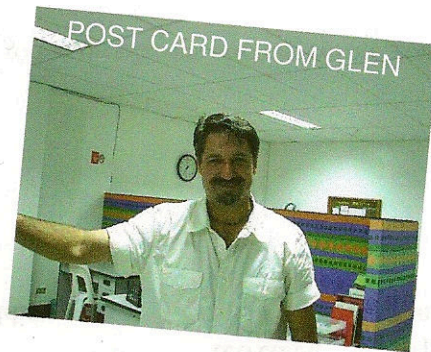


REMOTE ISLAND MINISTRIES

Hello everyone from the Philippines! As I write this we are prepared for a midnight departure on the mission vessel **RIM NATIVA** bound for Cape San Augustin. We hope to arrive by mid-morning on 25 January for a week of work among the brethren of Bethany Baptist Church. We are eleven souls on-board the boat, praying for God's blessing at sea.



RIM NATIVA lies stern-to at Sta. Ana Pier awaiting further provisioning of food, drinking water, block ice, personnel and effects. We have taken on 1,060 liters of diesel fuel and 1,500 liters of fresh water. A new piece of equipment we are especially thankful for is a 3,000,000 candle power remote controlled spotlight on the flying bridge...due for its first sea trial within a few hours!

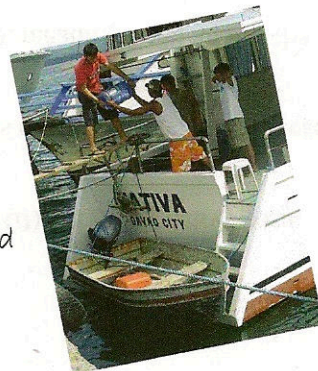

While this work is being accomplished we will divide our efforts and construct a proper sanitary waste system and toilet for the villagers.
