Its always a blessing for me to share to you once again the work and the progress of our mission here in Samal Island.

The Lord has blessed us so much ministries for us in this month. The parents association of my daughter nursery school has agreed to have a bible study every month for all the parents and it was started last august 22, 2011. there were 78 parents attended during our bible study last august 22. Because of this opportunity I was able to preach and to invite them to our church. Right now there were three families who showed us their desire and has invited us to their homes for bible study.



Aside from the efforts of my family and the joy that we received in the Lords work still we keep on scuffling against our present crises.

With in this month my family feel the crises that struck our nation. The dollar currency rate goes down, the food and fuel prices goes high

in my country. Likewise also the owner of the house that we rented has implemented an additional 1000 pesos increase to our previous rental. Now our house rental fee is 3000.00 pesos.

Though we are facing this crises, God remain certain to his promise to provide the need of his children. Likewise, the Philippine Missionary Baptist Seminary is also having difficulty taking care their students food and other school needs because of the shortage of funds and the low dollar rate exchange.

Our Suspended effort

Aside from ministering to adult, teaching children the word of God is one of our ground effort ways to reach out not only the children but also their parents. Every Saturday our young people with the leadership of our bible stu-

dent from the seminary were trying their best to teach the word of God. Every week end they were able to gather more than 60 children for bible story and be able to bring almost half of them to church. Right now we have 4 different places

(Villages) that were able to do bible story and 1 (Village) for children worship every Sunday 7 am in the Caliklik Multi-purpose Hall. This Sunday children worship was also requested by the Chief captain Mr. Richard Guindolman.

Just recently, our campus ministry has granted full authority from the school director to implement our plans and program for our organization. On the month of September we will be electing new set of officers and to recruit new members of our organization. This picture was taken last August 18, 2011 during our group bible study. There were 12 student and 1 faculty attended our group



bible study. My wife is working very hard with me everyday during the morning doing bible study and in the afternoon she takes care of our campus ministry

at the same time taking her courses. The school also appointed her as executive assistant for the school student congress (SSC). Every 3rd Wednesday of the month we have a worship service for our MBSF members and other students who desires to join. Sometimes some of the students who attended our school bible study visited our church worship.

Christ In our Crises part 2

Right now they are not using air-con in the office and library to conserve electricity. Please brethren pray for my family and the Philippine Missionary Baptist Seminary that God will supply the rest of our daily needs. Again this month of August we suffered shortage of food budget even if my wife and I have been adjusting our expenses but still for the last two weeks we find out short. Right now every time

I finished bible study and visitation every day I spend some of my remaining time working using my motorcycle to pick up some passengers and sometimes I gathered 70- 100 pesos to help manage some of our shortage budget.

My wife and I also thinking the possibility of living in the church's parsonage instead of renting in our present house for us to save some of our funds for emergencies. For now I am

inquiring for other ways to have electricity for our church that is not very expensive. Last week my 500 meters away neighbor has offered me an electricity connection from his house to our church (we called that connection Electrical Series) but I must provide our own electrical wire. For now my wife and I have kept on finding ways to save funds for the purpose of expanding our efforts to save some souls.

Mission outreach in the Island

So many good things had happened in this month not only for our church and other ministries but also for our mission outreach. In our mission in San Jose Village, the village officials has allocated for us a place to use as our place for children Bible study and adult bible study and prayer meeting. The Village captain himself and some of his village officials sometimes attended our bible study. In

this month my wife and I were able to visit our mission three times in a month and do our ministries there unlike before we're able to visit our mission points almost twice a week. In this month our attendance in our Mission in San Jose were 15 adult and 48 children. In Caliklik Village also our attendance were 11 adult with 14 children attending our bible study and cottage worship service every week. This com-

ing August 30 we will be visiting 3 families for Bible study in Kinawitnon Village Kasim Family (Muslim), Zone 9 of Caliklik Village Lomoljo Family and in Limao Village Jonaskie family (German husband with Filipina Wife). These three families were a family of one of Blessie's classmate who invited us for visitation and Bible study.
