We pray for a new home of Island Garden Baptist Church

May be some will ask why you need to find a new location? here are reasons why;

First, distance between the community and our church is not good. The nearest community we have is 1000 meters. For Filipinos distance matters the most.

Second, roads going to church is much rough and roughly especially on rainy season. People

will not visit our church when they are not comfortable on roads. Even our members feel dizzy going to our church.

Third, church growth. we are baptizing 1 soul for every 1 year in spite of constant labor. Compare to cult churches in the city proper they are growing numerically. Personally and God knows my heart I wont allow and I will not

stand in this island watching people marching to hell. Brethren we have to make a way to assure that the new testament church that Jesus built in this island be seen, be heard and grow. And the only way we can assure the growth of the church here in samal island is to establish this church in the right location.
