GETTING BACK TO THE BASICS:

ISAIAH'S VISION

(Isaiah 6:1-8)

Proverbs 29:18 “Where there is no vision, the people perish:” Vision- having the ability to see.

We must, as God's children, have a spiritual vision in our Christian life or we will perish. Perish means to waste away. We need to get to the place where Isaiah was, “here am I; send me”. Isaiah got to that place of commitment because he had a vision.

I. Isaiah Saw The Lord (v.1-5)

- A. He saw the Lord's Position. (v.1) A earthly king died but the Lord was still alive and well. He saw the Lord in His sovereignty.
- B. He saw the Lord's Personality. (v.2&3) He saw a thrice holy God. He is Holy in all three persons. His word, His will, and His work is holy.
- C. He saw the Lord's Presence. (v.4&5) When is the last time that we saw The King?
- D. We need to see what Isaiah saw every day in our life.

II. Isaiah Saw Isaiah (v.5-8)

- A. When Isaiah saw the Lord then he could finally see himself.
- B. Isaiah saw his personal need. (v.5) Once he saw his need he allowed the Lord to purge and cleanse his sin. (I John 1:8-10)
- C. Isaiah saw the public need. (v.5) Isaiah saw the need of the people. Isaiah saw a lost, sinful, and backslidden nation who need a cleansing from the Lord. (Ezra 9:6&7)

III. Isaiah Saw The Work (v.8)

- A. Isaiah saw the need of the people and then he realized that there was work to be done. “Here am I, Send me”. Lord take me and use me however you need too, so that souls might be saved and that your name is honored glorified. Isaiah became committed to the work of the Lord.
- B. The Lord is still seeking His people to work in His Kingdom. (Ezekiel 22:30)
- C. Are we surrendered to the Lord's work today?
