From The Pastor's Heart WHEN OUR WORLD IS UPSIDE DOWN

(Acts 17:1-7)

Introduction: "These that have turned the world upside down." This statement was the accusation against Paul and Silas. This statement was a untrue statement. They might of felt that way but the truth is Paul and Silas was turning the world downside up. Let's notice this morning the reason for the accusation.

I. The Preaching of The Gospel (v.2,3,5,&7)

- **A.** Notice the four things that Paul and Silas did.
 - 1. Reasoned- To ask questions and answers.
 - 2. Opening- To open fully, to explain.
 - **3.** Alleging- To lay down alongside, to prove.
 - **4.** Preaching- To announce.
- **B.** The Gospel was not received well by some and for good reason.
 - **1.** The Gospel opposed the traditions that they were accustomed to.
 - **2.** The Gospel opposed their lifestyle. The Gospel condemned their sin. People hate to be told they are wrong

II. The Passion of The Unbeliever (v.5-7)

- **A**. They immediately ran to the other people who were in opposition. (v.5) They were hurt and mad and had to get confirmation that they were right.
- **B.** "set the city on uproar" They were basically ganging up with others to oppose the preaching of the Gospel.
- C. They hated Paul and Silas and wanted them out of town. The message of the Gospel opposed their life and these people had a passion for their unbelief.

Conclusion: Don't let the Gospel turn your world upside down but let it turn it downside up. Be proud of the Gospel message.
